NOTES

Morning Colors. Morning colors is the traditional flag raising ceremony which occurs every morning at 8:00 am as per U.S. Navy regulations.

Staff Cadets. Staff Cadets collectively refers to cadets in designated billets: Leading Petty Officers (LPO), Master-At-Arms (MAA), and Squad Leaders.

After Action/Hotwash. An after action review or hotwash as it is called on submarines, is a short meeting of people in charge of an event used to determine what went well or what did not go well for that event. Our unit uses them to see if drill days went well.

Public Affairs Officer. The commanding officer's representative communicates with people outside the unit for the purpose of public relations.

Saluting. Saluting is required at the following times:

- a. Each time you meet the Commanding Officer when you are covered.
- b. When making a formal report.
- c. Upon your first meeting of the day with officers who are not the commanding officer.

Boards. Boards are used in the civilian world and in the military to certify people for positions of authority. In the Adirondack Battalion we will use them to ensure that cadets are ready for promotion and staff cadet positions.
